RESOLUTION NO. PA 18-02-002

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY OF PASSAIC  
AUTHORIZE THE DESIGNATION OF ADDITIONAL  
ON-STREET PARKING IN THE CITY OF PASSAIC.

WHEREAS, the Parking Authority of the City of Passaic (the "Authority"), a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, was created pursuant to the Parking Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:11A-1 et. seq. (the "Parking Authority Law") for the purposes of managing, operating, maintaining and improving certain parking facilities and meters located in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Passaic must designate by Ordinance duly adopted the designation of any parking facility, space or location within the City of Passaic, and the rate or rates to be charged therefor; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Passaic Parking Authority has caused a preliminary study of additional locations in and about the City of Passaic where additional parking meters might be installed, thereby creating additional parking for up to four hundred and sixty nine (469) paying parking spaces; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Passaic Parking Authority has determined that the provision of these additional paying parking spaces would assist in fulfilling the purposes of managing, operating, maintaining and improving certain parking facilities and meters located in the City, and further assist the merchants and residents of the City of Passaic in providing additional parking at these locations; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Passaic Parking Authority, in consultation with the Engineering Division of the City of Passaic, has determined that such locations are:

1. Academy Street between Main Avenue and Prospect Street (7 spaces); and,
2. Broadway between Randolph Street and Linden Street (9 spaces); and,
3. Central Avenue between Quincy Street and Lexington Avenue (35 spaces); and,
4. Dayton Avenue between Hobart Street and President Street (54 spaces); and,
5. Passaic Street between State Street and Eighth Street (61 spaces); and,
6. Main Avenue between Bond Street and Mass Court (23 spaces); and,
7. Main Avenue between Madison Street and Henry Street (3 spaces); and,
8. Main Avenue between Monroe Street and Highland Avenue ( 110 spaces); and,
9. Monroe Street between Main Avenue and Myrtle Avenue (49 spaces); and,
10. Monroe Street between Myrtle Avenue and Gregory Avenue (40 spaces); and,
11. Myrtle Avenue between Howe Avenue and Madison Street (15 spaces); and,
12. Prospect Street between Main Avenue and Pennington (63 spaces);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Parking Authority of the City of Passaic, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey that the City of Passaic Parking Authority requests that the City Council of the City of Passaic authorize by Ordinance additional metered parking of up to four hundred and sixty nine (469) spaces in and about the City of Passaic as aforesaid.


