ORDINANCE NO. 2188-18

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING SALARY RANGES FOR DEPARTMENT DIRECTORS,  
MUNICIPAL CLERK AND MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES FOR THE CITY OF PASSAIC,  
NEW JERSEY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal, and enforce such other ordinances, regulations, rules and by-laws not contrary to the laws of this state or of the United States, as it may deem necessary and proper for the good of government, order and protection of person and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by this subtitle, or by any law; and

WHEREAS, the City of Passaic believes it to be in the best interests of good of government, order and protection of person and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants to adopt the salary ranges set forth below for Department Directors, the Municipal Clerk, and Municipal Court Judges for the City of Passaic.

NOW IT BE ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Passaic, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION I**

All Department Directors and Municipal Clerk maximum annual salary range shall increase at the same rate as set forth in the Office & Professional Employee International (OPEIU) Union, Local 32 (City Employees) Collective Bargaining Agreement. All such salary range increase shall be retroactive to July 1, 2017 to those employees referenced herein who were entitled to such salary increase during that time but who did not receive same. Longevity and other benefits shall be paid in accordance with City personnel policies. All Municipal Court Judges maximum annual salary range increase shall be retroactive to February 2, 2018.

**SECTION II**

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as required by law.

**SECTION III**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed as to such inconsistency only.
